Module Contents	<p>Project work, with an either more theoretical or more conceptual weight, partly done in interdisciplinary groups, on selected issues out of the different fields of urban agglomerations</p> <p>Context analysis, formulation of project objectives and intended methodologies, collection, evaluation and synthesis of information, finalising of concepts and conclusions, scientific report and public presentation of the project</p> <p>Definition of the specific topic depending on the interests of the students and student groups and the particular teaching and research activities of the involved staff of „Urban Agglomerations“</p>
